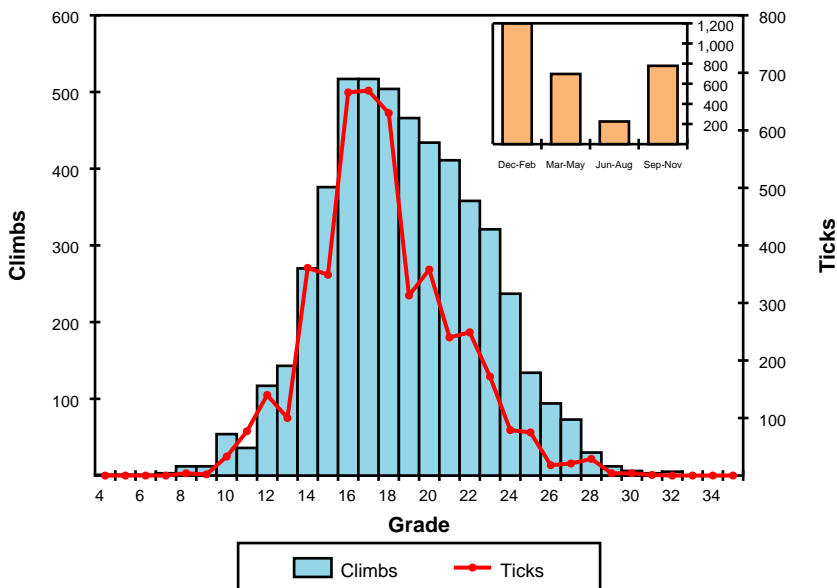

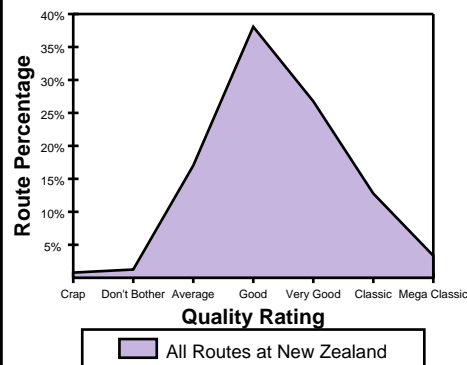

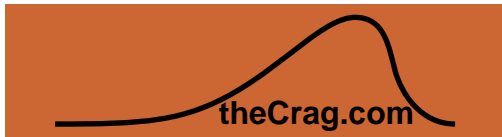
Ticks by Style Quality Ratings
